


- 51 staff from 12 countries at the end of 2017

New Members per Category, 2017




144 New Members in 2017, 1,554 Total Members at end of 2017

Membership Trends 2006-2017



 - Currently in



IPv6 Allocations




111 IPv6 allocations in 2017, totaling 113 /32s



ASN Assignment






150 ASNs assigned in 2017, 5 of these were "2 byte" ASNs, 1570 ASNs in total since 2004

- Training in French and English
 - Internet Number Resource Manager
 - IPv6 Planning and Deployment
- 21 workshops
- 19 countries
 - 639 participants



Outreach and Customer Service



- Attended 13 outreach events
- Met 300 members and prospective members
- Handled > 30,000 tickets
- 95% response within 48 hours
- Contacted 100% of members older than 1 year
- 80% updated their contact details

Policy Development



- "IPv4 Resource Transfers within the AFRINIC Region" passed and implemented
- "IPv4 Soft Landing bis" reached last call, but consensus declaration was overturned on appeal
- 7 other policy proposals discussed in 2017



Technical Operations



- Improvements to WHOIS authentication
 - Deprecated old password schemes
 - Added maintainers for all unprotected objects
- Deployed RPKI "0/0" trust anchor in collaboration with other RIRs
- DNS anycast service expansion
 - Free service to African ccTLDs
 - Increased from 3 to 8 locations



Research



- Africa Latency Study
 - "Most outstanding paper" at IEEE Africom 2017
 - Paper accepted to IEEE Infocom 2018
- 2 Measurement workshops
- The research team presented at 9 conferences



Fire Programme

AFRINIC The Internet Numbers Registry for Africa

- 9 grants in 2016/2017 with \$250,000 over 2 years
- 3 awards in 2017 of \$3,000 each
